

Pianist Andreas Teufel studied at the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz with Alexandr Satz and completed his studies in piano performance with distinction. Currently he works as a piano coach at the Univeristy of Music and Performing Arts Vienna. Before that he lectured as a coach at Graz University of Music and Performing Arts and at the China Conservatory in Beijing. He regularly conducted Lieder studios at the American “AIMS” summer festival in Graz and was holder of a Boesendorfer-scholarship as well as an honorary prize of the Austrian Federal Ministry for Science and Research. So far, his performances have led him from numerous European Countries as far as South Africa, Egypt, China or Ethiopia. In 2015 the extraordinary double CD „AUF! - A Sound Trek“ was released by Orlando Records together with the Austrian baritone Clemens Kölbl. Andreas is not only a multifaceted soloist, chamber music partner and coach but is also dedicated to the maintenance of the Austrian folk music tradition on the accordion and moreover holds a doctoral degree in mechanical engineering.
